

The `easy-todo` package

Abstract

The `easy-todo` package allows to add TODO notes all along the document and show the list of TODOs as an index with references.

1 Options

When including the package, the following options are available:

enabled Shows the TODO notes as well as the index.

disabled Hides the TODO notes as well as the index. Useful for printing drafts without the TODO notes but keeping them in the document.

final Same as disabled.

chapter Prints the list of TODOs as a chapter.

section Prints the list of TODOs as a section.

For example:

```
\usepackage[enabled,section]{easy-todo}
```

2 Commands

`\todo{note}` Adds in the same location a TODO note with text `note`.

`\listoftodos` Creates the list of TODOs in the same location as used.
